## Here are some updates and information:

**Medication at school:** Please remember to bring in all medications and forms to the Health Office as soon as possible. We are not allowed to give students medications without a form signed by the doctors office and you must provide all medications. We do have a special peanut free table in the lunchroom. If your child needs to sit at this table please notify your child's teacher and the Health Aide. If you have any questions please email our Health Aide, Mrs. Mindy.

**Hats at school:** Our superintendent has lifted the "no hats" policy in all of our Adams 12 Schools. As an ex-high school dean, this was a bit of a shock for me, but I'm over it now:). Students may wear hats at school. I have shared with the staff, like with anything that is brought into the school, if it becomes a distraction, interferes with learning, etc., then we will handle that individually.

**Our school's social media:** Silver Creek Elementary has <u>Facebook</u> and <u>Twitter</u>. I run both of these accounts. These accounts are only used for celebrating and communicating. If you have any questions or comments regarding anything related to the school, please feel free to contact me through my

## After school pick up:

- The parking lot will be closed to ALL cars (except handicap stickered cars)
- This is for the safety of all at Silver Creek
- If you are in the lot before it is closed off you may NOT park in the hug n go, you will need to park in a parking spot
- Cross at the crosswalks ONLY
- Cars in the lot will not be allowed out until MOST of the families have crossed through the crosswalks
- NO parking or crossing on 152nd Ave (north of the school)
- If you might be late, please call the main office at 720-972-3940 and let them know so we can bring your child to the office before release
- No U-turns in or around the school where students and families are present
- Please communicate with your child and let them know where you will meet them after school
- Students and families will need to leave the school ground as soon as school is over and pick up has occurred. Our playgrounds are reserved for our B.A.S.E. program until 6:00 P.M.
