Security at SCE/ RAPTOR

All outside doors are locked for entry at Silver Creek Elementary. The only access point for visitors is our front door. At the front door you must ring the doorbell and wait there while our office staff sees you through a camera and welcomes you in. The right door will then unlock and you can enter the building.

Upon entering the building, you must stop at the office to check in with our office staff.

Raptor is a visitor registration system that enhances school security by reading visitor drivers' licenses, comparing information to a sex offender database, alerting campus administrators if a match is found, and then (assuming no match was made) printing a visitor badge with a photo.

Silver Creek Elementary asks that you have your driver's license scanned through the Raptor system EVERY school year if you intend to enter our school as a volunteer, field trip chaperone or classroom visitor.

Our principal takes security and student safety very seriously. Our staff carries walkie talkies and keeps in close communication around security. We have a Security Alert system and do lock down drills regularly so our staff and students are prepared in the event of an emergency.
