

Google Drive: How to access at home

As an Adams 12 student, your child has his/her own Google account. These accounts are used for educational purposes at school and can also be accessed at home to share learning with families and/or to work on assignments at home. Students are learning how to be responsible digital citizens while using these accounts.

To access Google Drive:

- Go to the Silver Creek website: <https://silvercreek.adams12.org/>
- Select Learning Resources.
- Select Links.
- Click on Google Drive.
- Choose either Google Drive or Google Classroom (for classrooms that use this system).
- Enter your student login. On a computer, use your STUDENT ID NUMBER.
- Enter your password.

To login to a Chromebook at home:

- Login using your EMAIL ADDRESS.
 - Here's the formula for knowing your email address:
 - First letter of first name
 - 3 letters of last name
 - Date of birth (not month or year)
 - Last 4 numbers of student ID
 - @adams12.orgExample: tbar279963@adams12.org
- Enter your password.
- Google apps should appear as icons on the bottom left of your Chromebook screen. If not, follow the steps above to access Google Drive.
